The following Administrative Rule is promulgated by the SWA General Manager/Engineer for implementation and enforcement of the SWA Business Recycling Ordinance, adopted by the SWA Board as Ordinance No. 21.

**Requirements of Franchised Waste Haulers**

Section 4.01.090 allows the General Manager/Engineer and/or his or her designee to restrict the hours of collection of solid waste or recyclable materials by franchised waste haulers in designated areas.

The following parcels in Sacramento County including the address 2381 Fair Oaks Boulevard, being designated for commercial solid waste and recycling collection no sooner than 8 am, no later than 5 pm, on a Monday through Friday schedule only:
